[The 21st Century High-Performing Public School Facilities Act](#) - would provide \$6.4 billion dollars for green school construction and improvements to public schools in the U.S.

Missouri Legislation:

[Senate Bill 964](#) - Creates the Show Me Green Sales Tax Holiday and provides financial assistance for voluntary energy audits, sponsored by Senator Jeff Smith

[Senate Bill 1181](#) - Modifies and creates provisions regarding energy efficiency and energy conservation, sponsored By Senator Engler

[Senate Bill 1261](#) - Creates requirements and provides incentives for energy efficient products and activities, sponsored by Senator Bray
